HMS School for Children with Cerebral Palsy (HMS) is a day and residential school for students through age 22 who have complex, multiple disabilities usually resulting from cerebral palsy, traumatic brain injury, or other neurological impairment. HMS provides highly individualized special education and intensive coordinated therapy in preparation for return to a less intensive local school program or transition for older students to maximize their potential in the community. HMS's interdisciplinary team reinforces students' learning as teachers collaborate
